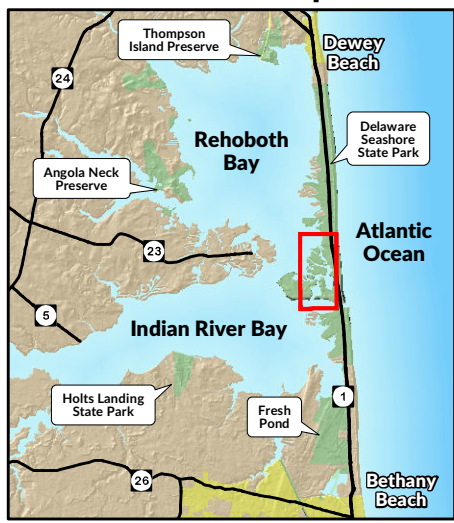


Delaware Seashore State Park

About the Course

Enjoy the expansive salt marsh habitat and wildlife viewing opportunities the parks bayside has to offer. The marsh islands in this area are important nesting areas for a variety of birds including Osprey, Forster's and Common Terns, American Oystercatcher and Clapper Rail. Paddlers can access the water from the launch located behind the drystack storage near Burton Island. The trail makes a 2.8 mile loop around the Cedar Islands. The course is specifically geared toward the experienced kayaker. Heat, wind, and tide are all factors that can make it a challenge even for the experienced paddler. Please respect important nesting habitats along the course and remain in your kayak. Please note: this entire area is an active waterfowl hunting area from October to February.
